General Description

Camp Nurses are responsible for:

- Providing quality care and service to our entire camp community
- Coordinate coverage of health center to ensure 24/7 care
- Administering medicine and supplements
- Ensuring all camp health protocols are followed
- Maintaining the health, welfare, and safety of all campers
- Establishing and operating a well-organized camp health center
- Promoting a healthy living environment for the camp community throughout the season
- Liaising with visiting doctors and other medical professionals outside of camp
- Clearly documenting (in camp health software) all medications/supplements, visits to the health center, injuries, illnesses, etc.
- Triaging all camper/staff visits to the Health Center
- Administering healthcare to campers and staff consistent with protocols developed by the Medical Committee and/or the camper's physician



- communicate effectively and promptly with a diverse audience: campers, parents/guardians, staff, medical colleagues, leadership team, and support staff per camp guidelines.
- Refer to medical treatment outside of camp per camp guidelines and protocols
- Other health-related administrative duties as required by the Summer Camp Director.

Qualifications/Requirements

- Active/Current Registered Nurse's License (RN) for Washington State, required.
- Other licensed training will be considered, such as, licensed nurse practitioner.
- 3+ years of school and/or pediatric/adolescent medical experience strongly preferred.
- 3+ years working in a clinical setting/environment with children preferred.
- Skills to communicate effectively and promptly with a diverse audience: campers, parents/guardians, staff, medical colleagues, leadership team, and support staff.
- Current certifications in first aid, CPR, and AED.
- Hands-on skills and experience with maintaining accurate records electronically and keeping an orderly workspace.

This position is exempt, temporary, and full-time for the summer (\$1,250-\$1,500 per week; DOE). Room and board included. Summer camp runs from 6/19/2024 – 8/15/2024.
